Contains 0.1% w/w pyrethrins (as pyrethrum powder) and piperonyl butoxide 0.80% w/w

**6. INDICATION(S)**

What does this powder do?

Wilko cat flea powder controls fleas on your cat and prevents their return for 3-4 days. AS fleas can also live in your carpets and in your cat's bedding you should treat these areas with a suitable insecticide and vacuum regularly.

**7. CONTRAINDICATIONS**

Is this powder safe for my cats?

Yes, however you should not use it if your cat is less than 12 weeks old, or is feeding kittens. In all of these cases, use a flea comb or speak to a vet. Do not use on nursing females.

## **10. DOSAGE FOR EACH SPECIES, ROUTE(S) AND METHOD OF ADMINISTRATION**

Only use when your cat's coat is dry. Stand the animal on a sheet of paper or outdoors and comb or brush the coat the wrong way, to expose the skin underneath, then apply a total of 5-10 g of powder directly to the skin. This pack contains sufficient powder for 8-16 applications. . Brush excess powder off the coat taking care to avoid the eyes and other sensitive areas. Brush out the coat after 30 minutes and do not allow the animal to groom itself until this has been done. Do not use the powder more than once a week

## **13. SPECIAL STORAGE PRECAUTIONS**

Store in a dry place.

Do not store above 25°C.

## **14. SPECIAL WARNING(S)**

Do not use the powder whilst using any other flea control products on your cat. Do not use any other insecticide on your cat within 7 days of treatment. Avoid getting into your cat's eyes, mouth or ears or other sensitive areas. This powder is for external use only. If signs of disease persist or appear consult your veterinary surgeon. In case of adverse reaction, consult your veterinary surgeon.

Avoid inhaling the powder. Use in a well ventilated area.

Wash hands and exposed skin after use.

Avoid contact with eyes. In case of accidental eye contact, rinse with clean, fresh water. If eye irritation persists, seek medical advice.

Persons who are hypersensitive (allergic) to pyrethrum extract should handle the product with care.

Treated animals should not be allowed to sleep or play with people, particularly children, until the powder has been brushed out.

Keep away from food and drink, including animal feeding stuffs.
