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#### **I. SCIENTIFIC OVERVIEW**

The quality / safety / efficacy aspects of this product is/are identical to Beaphar Soft Cat Flea Collar, 18% w/w. The initial application for Beaphar Soft Cat Flea Collar, 18% w/w was assessed before there was a requirement to have a public assessment report; therefore no details in this section are available.
