2. NAME OF THE VETERINARY MEDICINAL PRODUCT

3. STATEMENT OF THE ACTIVE SUBSTANCE(S) AND OTHER INGREDIENT(S)

Each dose (2 ml) contains: Active substance: Inactivated porcine circovirus (PCV) type 2b, strain Rm: ≥1,100 AU* Adjuvants: Light liquid paraffin 157 mg *Escherichia coli* J5 LPS 2,500 – 38,000 EU** Preservative: Thiomersal 50 μg * Antigenic Units as determined in the *in-vitro* potency test (ELISA) ** Endotoxin Units

Off-white, homogeneous emulsion.

The vaccine should not be used if the appearance of the product is not off-white, homogeneous emulsion after shaking.

4. INDICATION(S)

For the active immunization of fattening pigs from 3 weeks of age, to reduce viraemia, virus load in lymphoid tissues and virus shedding caused by porcine circovirus type 2 (PCV2) infection. To reduce weight loss associated with PCV2 infection during the fattening period.

Onset of immunity: 3 weeks after vaccination Duration of immunity: 24 weeks after vaccination

5. CONTRAINDICATIONS

None.

6. ADVERSE REACTIONS

A transient mean increase in body temperature of approximately 1.5°C is very common on the day of vaccination as shown in safety studies. In individual cases the maximum increase may reach 2oC, but the body temperature returns to normal levels within 12-24 hours.

A local reaction at the site of injection in the form of slight swelling and reddish colorization with a diameter up to 5 cm was very commonly observed during the safety studies, which lasts in general for not longer than three to four days. These reactions are of transient nature and do not need further treatment.

Diarrhoea is very common post vaccination as observed in safety studies. Immediate, mild hypersensitivity-like reactions uncommonly occur after vaccination in studies resulting in transient clinical signs such as vomiting. These clinical signs normally resolve without treatment.

The frequency of adverse reactions is defined using the following convention: - very common (more than 1 in 10 animals displaying adverse reactions during the course of one treatment)

- common (more than 1 but less than 10 animals in 100 animals)
- uncommon (more than 1 but less than 10 animals in 1,000 animals)
- rare (more than 1 but less than 10 animals in 10,000 animals)
- very rare (less than 1 animal in 10,000 animals, including isolated reports).

If you notice any serious effects or other effects not mentioned in this package leaflet, please inform your veterinary surgeon.

7. TARGET SPECIES

Pigs (pigs for fattening)

8. DOSAGE FOR EACH SPECIES, ROUTE(S) AND METHOD OF ADMINISTRATION

For intramuscular use. Vaccinate pigs in the side of their neck. Administer a single dose of 2 ml from 3 weeks of age.

9. ADVICE ON CORRECT ADMINISTRATION

Shake well before use.

Use sterile syringe and needle, respect aseptic conditions of vaccination.

10. WITHDRAWAL PERIOD

Zero days.

11. SPECIAL STORAGE PRECAUTIONS

Keep out of the sight and reach of children. Store and transport refrigerated (2°C – 8°C). Do not freeze. Protect from light.

Do not use this veterinary medicinal product after the expiry date which is stated on the label.

Shelf life after first opening the container: 10 hours

12. SPECIAL WARNING(S)

Special warnings for each target species:

None.

<u>Special precautions for use in animals</u> Vaccinate only healthy animals.

Special precautions to be taken by the person administering the veterinary medicinal product to animals

In case of accidental self-injection, seek medical advice immediately and show the package leaflet or the label to the physician.

To the user:

This veterinary medicinal product contains mineral oil. Accidental injection/selfinjection may result in severe pain and swelling, particularly if injected into a joint or finger, and in rare cases could result in the loss of the affected finger if prompt medical attention is not given. If you are accidentally injected with this veterinary medicinal product, seek prompt medical advice even if only a very small amount is injected and take the package leaflet with you. If pain persists for more than 12 hours after medical examination, seek medical advice again.

To the physician:

This veterinary medicinal product contains mineral oil. Even if small amounts have been injected, accidental injection with this product can cause intense swelling, which may, for example, result in ischaemic necrosis and even the loss of a digit. Expert and PROMPT surgical attention is required and may necessitate early incision and irrigation of the injected area, especially where there is involvement of finger pulp or tendon.

<u>Pregnancy and lactation</u>: Not applicable.

Interaction with other medicinal products and other forms of interaction:

No information is available on the safety and efficacy of this vaccine when used with any other veterinary medicinal product. A decision to use this vaccine before or after any other veterinary medicinal product therefore needs to be made on a case by case basis.

<u>Overdose (symptoms, emergency procedures, antidotes)</u>: No data available.

Incompatibilities:

Do not mix with any other veterinary medicinal product.

13. SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS FOR THE DISPOSAL OF UNUSED PRODUCT OR WASTE MATERIALS, IF ANY

Any unused veterinary medicinal product or waste materials derived from such veterinary medicinal product should be disposed of in accordance with local requirements.

Immunological properties:

Pharmacotherapeutic group: Inactivated viral vaccines for pigs – porcine circovirus. ATCvet code: QI09AA07.

Inactivated whole virus vaccine based on an immunogenic PCV2b strain. This antigen is incorporated in an adjuvant for stimulation of immunity, based on a combination of light liquid paraffin and cell free Escherichia coli J5 LPS. The vaccine stimulates the development of active immunity against porcine circovirus type 2.

Pack sizes:

Low density polyethylene bottles sealed with rubber stopper and aluminium cap. 1x50 ml, 1x100 ml, 1x250 ml, 1x500 ml, 5x50 ml, 5x100 ml, 6x250 ml, 6x500 ml, 10x50 ml, 10x100 ml, 10x250 ml or 10x500 ml bottles in a carton box. Not all pack sizes may be marketed.
