Clinical Mastitis

At each milking rub in sufficient Golden Udder to cover the infected quarter, (approx. 20-30 g – up to 1 level tablespoon). Continue treatment for a minimum of three days. If symptoms persist consult your veterinary surgeon.

Wash and dry udders and teats before milking.

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At calving down

For udder health and as an aid in the control of mastitis, at a vulnerable time, use as for clinical mastitis.

Minor skin conditions

For minor skin conditions anywhere on the animal apply to the affected area twice a day until the condition clears.

If signs of disease persist or appear consult your veterinary surgeon.
