NATURE/TYPE: low density polyethylene lined multi-walled paper bag

1. NAME OF THE VETERINARY MEDICINAL PRODUCT

Potencil 10% Premix for medicated feed

2. STATEMENT OF ACTIVE SUBSTANCES

PRESENTATION

A grey, free flowing powder for incorporation into animal feed, containing 10% phenoxymethylpenicillin potassium (100 g/kg).

3. PHARMACEUTICAL FORM

Potencil

Premix for medicated feed.

4. PACKAGE SIZE

2 kg 25 kg

5. TARGET SPECIES

Pigs

6. INDICATION(S)

USES

For the treatment and control of streptococcal meningitis and septicaemia caused by *Streptococcus suis* II in pigs. Also for the treatment and control of porcine pleuropneumonia caused by *Actinobacillus* (*Haemophilus*) *pleuropneumoniae* and treatment and control of secondary bacterial pneumonia caused by *Pasteurella multocida*.

FURTHER INFORMATION

On commercial pig farms, Potencil has been shown to be very effective in the control and treatment of streptococcal meningitis/septicaemia and control of *Actinobacillus pleuropneumoniae and Pasteurella multocida* infections.

7. METHOD AND ROUTE(S) OF ADMINISTRATION

DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION

For oral administration after incorporation in pelleted feed or meal at an inclusion level of 2 kg Potencil per tonne of feed. This is approximately equivalent to 10 mg phenoxymethylpenicillin potassium per kg bodyweight daily.

To be fed *ad-libitum* for up to 6 consecutive weeks for meningitis/septicaemia, and up to 2 weeks for pleuropneumonia/pneumonic pasteurellosis. Freshly manufactured medicated diet should be supplied every 2 weeks.

To allow thorough dispersion of the product, Potencil should be mixed with a small quantity of feed ingredients prior to mixing into the bulk of the feed. In pelleting, the mix can be pre-conditioned with steam for up to 5 minutes and processed at temperatures in the feed of up to 70°C. After incorporation under these conditions, Potencil retains satisfactory activity for 2 weeks. Accurate mixing is essential. Avoid the introduction of contamination during use.

8. WITHDRAWAL PERIOD(S)

WITHDRAWAL PERIOD:

Animals must not be slaughtered for human consumption during treatment. Pigs may be slaughtered for human consumption only after 24 hours (1 day) from the last treatment.

9. SPECIAL WARNING(S), IF NECESSARY

CONTRA-INDICATIONS, WARNINGS:

Not for direct feeding. Not for use in liquid feed. Not for use in animals known to be hypersensitive to penicillins.

Studies to determine the safety of this product for use during pregnancy have not been conducted in pigs. Use in pregnant pigs should be in accordance with a benefit/risk assessment by the responsible veterinarian.

Not for handling by operatives with known sensitivity to penicillins.

Operator Warnings: Penicillins and cephalosporins may cause hypersensitivity (allergy) following injection, inhalation, ingestion or skin contact. Hypersensitivity to penicillins may lead to cross reactions to cephalosporins and vice versa. Allergic reactions to these substances may occasionally be serious. Do not handle this product if you know you are sensitised, or if you have been advised not to work with such preparations.

Handle this product with great care to avoid exposure, taking all recommended precautions. Skin sensitisation may occur, care should be taken to avoid direct skin contact by wearing protective clothing, gloves and a dust mask, either a disposable half-mask respirator conforming to European Standard EN149 or a non-disposable respirator to European Standard EN140 with a filter to EN143, when preparing medicated feed. If you develop symptoms following exposure, such as a skin rash, you should seek medical advice and show the doctor this warning. Swelling of the face, lips or eyes, or difficulty with breathing, are more serious symptoms and require urgent medical attention. Wash hands after use.

After inclusion of Potencil, feed must be used before the end of a fourteen-day period from manufacture, due to loss of potency of the active ingredient.

Store in a dry place. Do not store above 25°C. Close container after use.
